on the Christ Church web site is now available to people wanting to find out about their Hutt Valley ancestors.

The Committee has employed Ben Collis of Digital Promotions to make all the data in the Genealogy Section of the web site searchable. To find family members associated with Christ Church you enter the name and then the information appears. The ancestor record data and the supplementary documents are all there. If you have information about a person or activity associated with Christ Church that you would like to include in your family history send it to info@christ-church.org.nz. The committee will vet the information and then put it on the website for you.

Another must see on the Web page is the 3D walk through of the graveyard. There is a search facility with which you can find the position of any grave in the graveyard.
